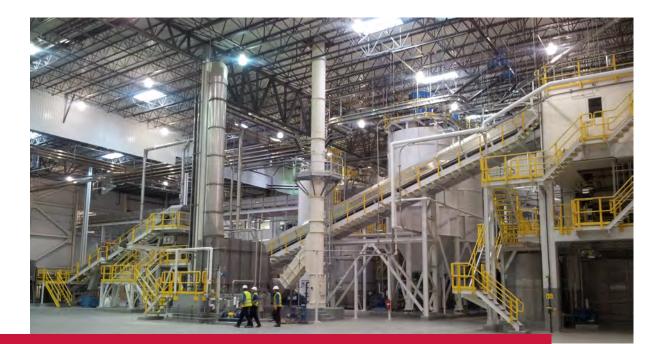
The role of IT and the challenges of tomorrow

Information Technology is considered by Engitec to represent an opportunity for business growth and development. Within this perspective, it is important for the company to work with suppliers that are capable of guaranteeing full-spectrum innovation, alongside technological excellence.

As Engitec's IT manager Antonio Fratepietro notes: "We work with market leaders that not only support us in the immediate term, but also enable us to realise long-term strategies".

Managing security across the board

In order for a business to be truly safe, all links in the chain have to be suitably protected. This can only be done by maintaining a complete and integrated approach. Ricoh carried out a detailed analysis Engitec's activities and processes in order to identify and manage vulnerabilities. On the basis of the results obtained, a project was developed focusing in particular on three stands:

- Multi-factor authentication for VPN (user ID + password + token)
- Immutable Back up: files backed up cannot in any way be canceled or altered, and so can be swiftly restored in the event of an attack. In addition, these files can only be accessed by system administrators, and in order to do so they have to be physically present in the office.
- Endpoint security through the implementation of the SentinelOne solution proposed by Ricoh. SentinelOne is a cybersecurity platform with autonomous response capability. SentinelOne Singularity is the only cybersecurity platform that incorporates prevention, detection, response and research based on Artificial Intelligence for endpoints, containers, cloud workloads and IoT devices within one single XDR platform.

"SentinelOne constantly detects telemetry relating to everything that happens at endpoint level, looking for patterns of conduct and responding appropriately whenever an anomaly occurs. For example, if the files on a PC are suddenly encrypted, the software blocks the action and sends an alert in real time to the IT department, which can then isolate the device from the rest of the network. Since we installed this solution a number of IT attacks have already occurred, and all of them have been blocked without any impact on our business".

Keeping up with change

Antonio Fratepietro concludes: "Thanks to the help we have received from Ricoh and its constant support, along with the adoption of the SentinelOne platform, we have entered into a new technological era. We have access to state-of-the-art devices and solutions that guarantee the highest security. This means that we can keep up with change and sleep soundly because our information is safe".
