COMPANY & CHALLENGE

The Cantonal Printed Matter and Supplies Office (kdmz) of the Canton of Zurich in Switzerland produces a wide range of print output for the Canton of Zurich administration and other regional government departments and organisations. As central service provider, kdmz procures and prints ballot papers, official forms, legal texts, brochures, tax statements, and other official documents for the 33,000 administration staff and the 1.58 million people who live in the canton.

The Canton of Zurich is an economic powerhouse and has been growing in population for many years. This growth places greater pressure on official organisations as they aim to deliver high quality citizen services. For example, it has become increasingly difficult for the central print office of kdmz to ensure timely production of important publications and documents.

Rolf Thoma, Head of Procurement and Printing at kdmz, says: "In the first six months of a year especially, we print many time-critical documents. These are highly sensitive print jobs, which we can't give to external printers. Our old colour print solution could not deliver the speed and output quality we needed. We had to increase our inhouse capacity to facilitate seamless operations and ensure citizens received relevant documents on time."



As part of a public authority and the lead buyer for publications, office supplies and output systems for the Canton of Zurich, kdmz regularly organises public tender processes. To increase its print capabilities, kdmz launched a public tender process to find new solutions covering a contract period of five years.

kdmz carefully reviewed all submissions for the tender process, evaluating the weighted criteria before determining that Ricoh achieved the highest score.
