Leipzig International School (LIS) is an independent, non-profit co-educational school in Germany. With over 1,000 students of all ages and around 200 teachers and administrative staff, LIS strives to create an inclusive learning community in a multi-lingual learning environment. Fostering creativity and entrepreneurial skills through interdisciplinary learning, the school focuses on academic as well as personal growth to inspire students. LIS offers widely recognised qualifications such as the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme.

To develop a more inclusive and stimulating learning experience, Leipzig International School (LIS) wanted to modernise its classrooms. The school was looking to replace ageing whiteboards and projectors with cutting-edge educational technologies in a major upgrade of its educational equipment.

Jocelyn Gamble, Education Technology Specialist at LIS emphasizes the school's forward-looking approach, asserting, "We want to position ourselves for the future, delivering a cutting-edge educational experience. The aspiration is to be at the forefront of innovation, creating a state-of-the-art educational environment for both teachers and students. One regular complaint from teachers was the limited brightness and image and sound quality of the existing equipment, which made it difficult for some students to engage with educational content. The school began the search for a solution with rich functionality that would enable truly captivating learning experiences.

Solution

Focusing the search on advanced interactive whiteboards, LIS evaluated more than four educational technology vendors and requested demonstration units to really put the systems through their paces. A standout offering soon emerged: Ricoh A8600 Interactive Whiteboards.



The Ricoh interactive whiteboards feature electrical height adjustment and ultra-responsive touch input, enabling a smooth experience for teachers and students. Powerful built-in speakers ensure clear audio throughout the whole classroom for multimedia and video content, and make separate speakers or soundbars unnecessary.

"The Ricoh interactive whiteboards are clearly designed with the classroom in mind," says Jocelyn Gamble. "They are very easy to use and very reliable. For example, the EShare app gives teachers wireless connectivity that lets them share their laptop or tablet screen on the whiteboard, without having to worry about setting up cables. And thanks to the simple user experience, it's also easy for teachers to explore and discover new features and capabilities to make the best use of the new whiteboards for their lessons."

LIS worked closely with Ricoh to deploy 21 Ricoh A8600 Interactive Whiteboards, including a mobile unit. To minimise the impact of the upgrade, Ricoh completed the installation quickly during school holidays.

Often it is the little things that make a big difference, such as being able to change the background of the whiteboard for different subjects and topics in an instant."

Facilitating inclusion and accessibility are important at LIS and the new Ricoh interactive whiteboards have had a positive impact in these areas, too. "We want to break down barriers to learning and ensure every student feels engaged and participates fully in lessons," explains Stefanie Amann. "The whiteboard screens are sharp and easy-to-read even for students with visual impairments. And being able to have two or three students work on a single whiteboard at the same time increases engagement during lessons. In the primary school, being able to control what's on the whiteboard while sitting in a circle is another great benefit that aids group working."

Beyond everyday teaching, the new interactive whiteboards help LIS to make more efficient use of its space during events and staff meetings. "For larger meetings with parents we can show the same content across multiple whiteboards in different classrooms," says Jocelyn Gamble. "This is very handy when we cannot fit all attendees in a single room. The new whiteboards are also a great tool to support our strong media studies focus, as

we can use them to present completed projects, including high-quality video and audio elements."

In addition, LIS has installed an interactive whiteboard in the cafeteria, allowing the space to be used for meetings and lessons when needed.

"We are just getting started," confirms Stefanie Amann.

"There is so much more potential for how the Ricoh
interactive whiteboards can change the way our students
learn. We're now working with our teachers to adjust and
develop curriculums to take advantage of all the new
possibilities."
