

Using this setup, a user can contact their IT service desk and request a device or suite of technology. IT will then process the request, and a pick-up code will be sent to the end-user to collect the goods from a Smart Locker.

If you don't use an IT service delivery platform, the embedded Smart Locker technology can offer a similar end-user experience.

In a modern workspace, Smart Lockers create a professional and automated system for deliveries and can save time for all involved in the process. Packages are scanned into a mail management system and allocated to a locker.

An application or device will then alert the addressee and provide pickup instructions.

Alternatively, the Smart Locker can be used without integration into an existing system and still offer notifications to the recipient.





Logistics & Warehousing

The volume of organisations selling their goods in the global marketplace has grown in recent years, fuelled by digitisation and the power of global trade.

To cater for increased demand, warehousing and logistics firms need to enhance staff productivity and increase visibility of key assets.

Installing Smart Lockers can help your organisation improve performance, reduce cost and automate manual tasks which take significant time.

Smart Lockers can automate the management of hand-held terminals and business-critical devices, minimising loss, damage and management time.

6.1 Device management

Distribution of hand-held terminals to employees at the beginning or end of their shift can be time-consuming. Equally, it can be challenging to manage employees who take devices without following protocol.

These factors can cause your organisation to lose valuable picking minutes and breed a lack of accountability for high-value devices.

Warehousing and logistics Smart Lockers can be used to distribute devices quickly and efficiently at the point of need. Assets are displayed and can be accessed using a PIN code or ID card.



6.3 Parcel & document delivery

In warehouse environments, there is often a need to ensure employees are issued the correct paperwork.

In this case, Smart Lockers can act as a central hub for internal deliveries meaning office-based staff have a safe place to drop off documentation without venturing into the shop floor. Documents or packages are allocated to a locker. An application will then alert the addressee and provide pickup instructions.





Parcel lockers are automated parcel machines that can serve as alternative delivery locations or constitute a stand-alone delivery network. For logistics companies, investment in parcel lockers can reduce costs in the logistics chain, increase delivery efficiency and decrease the last-mile-related greenhouse gas emissions on the delivery company side.

In 2020, parcel locker use increased in Europe, with a 230% uplift in online shopping. By offering a more extensive Smart Locker service, logistics firms only stand to strengthen their position.

Using Smart Lockers can refine your customer experience and encourage more users to save costs in the long term, and streamline processes.

Smart Lockers enable logistics companies and couriers to deliver multiple packages in the same place, saving time but most importantly saving cost - up to 53% of the total delivery cost is on the last mile. From a sustainability perspective, Smart Lockers can also reduce the need for inefficient parcel delivery routes, which increase the carbon footprint of deliveries.
